



What to do if you have any concerns ...

Your first point of contact for any concern is always your child's class teacher.

If your class teacher cannot resolve your concern, your next point of contact is the Key Stage Leader.

Early Years and Key Stage 1 - Miss S Abbotts
Key Stage 2 - Mr A Nash

The vast majority of concerns can be resolved informally. It is in everyone's best interests that complaints are resolved at the earliest possible stage. This can usually be achieved through discussion and good communication. However, if you are not satisfied with the outcome, a formal procedure (as outlined in our complaints policy) would then need to be followed when attempts to resolve the issue are unsuccessful.
